



## **Villa del Mar Slip Application Acceptance Criteria**

- 1) All applicants must submit a fully completed, signed application, receipt form and documentation outlined below.
- 2) Recent color photos of the vessel (3"x 5" or larger) must accompany applications and provide a local mooring of the vessel where a visual inspection can be completed (in MdR only).
- 3) All vessels under application for moorage at Villa del Mar Marina must be found in good to excellent operational and mechanical condition. Vessel appearance must exhibit excellent care and owner pride relating to cosmetic condition and maintenance at all times while moored in Villa del Mar Marina.
- 4) Vessel must meet all applicable requirements of the Villa del Mar Marina, its Rules and Regulations, and all applicable rules and regulations of the State of California including the Los Angeles Department of Beaches and Harbors rules and regulations as they may apply.
- 5) All vessels, prior to acceptance, must have a current and valid State Registration, or U.S. Coast Guard Documentation available for inspection.
- 6) Owner must name Villa del Mar as additional insured on insurance policy and present a copy to Villa del Mar Rental Office showing minimum coverage of \$300,000.
- 7) All applicants who have been accepted based on the above criteria will be subject to a credit check. There is a \$40.00 non-refundable credit check fee charged to the applicant. No vessel will be permitted to moor at Villa del Mar Marina if the registered owner does not pass. Check should be made payable to Far West Management.
- 8) Owner must provide proof of income (2 – 3 current pay stubs or other proof when not paid by regular payroll evidence).
- 9) Owner must provide a check for the slip security deposit made payable to Far West Management. Security deposit amounts vary.
- 10) Owner shall provide Villa del Mar with a copy of his/her Driver License.
- 11) Vessels applying for live aboard status must receive approval from the Villa del Mar Marina prior to move in if accepted. Live aboard vessels shall be a minimum of 36 feet in length and have on board all necessary equipment to support a live aboard status and lifestyle. All live aboard vessels must have gray and black water tanks for pump out purposes. No vessel shall pump out tanks directly overboard within the marina or the Marina del Rey basin area. All live aboard vessels must first apply to the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department and receive a County Approved Live Aboard sticker prior to exercising their live aboard status.
- 12) No application for Commercial Use Vessels will be considered whose owner intends to conduct commercial operations from Villa del Mar Marina.
- 13) Vessels found acceptable will be approved based upon availability of a suitable and appropriate slip.
